FATHER ROLLIN JEAN-MARIE FLORES

SUPERIOR OF THE PROVINCE OF PHILIPPINES-MACAU



The Superior General, Father Valdir José De Castro, appointed him by decree of 12 March 2019, after obtaining the consent of his Council.

Born in Quezon City (Philippines) on 3 August 1962, Father Rollin joined the Society of Saint Paul in 1988. He made his first profession in Makati on 9 June 1991 and his perpetual profession, again in Makati, on 29 June 1997. He was consecrated a priest on 3 October 1998 for the laying on of hands of Mons. Crisostomo A. Yalung.

A graduate in Political Sciences before joining the Congregation, Father Rollin completed his philosophical and theological studies at the Loyola School of Theology in Manila in 1996. During and after the initial formation he devoted himself to the editorial sector, in particular collaborating with the Sunday liturgical sheet *Sambuhay*. From 2002, he was a Master of the Juniors for a few years, collaborating as well in the creative sector. Since 2004 until today, he was Director of *Simbahay*, an annual liturgical agenda in *Tagalog*. From 2008, he has been administrator and then Parish Priest of the Church of "Our Lady of Sorrows" in Pasay City. In 2005, he has participated in the Formation Course on the Charism of the Pauline Family. In 2011, finally, he was appointed member of the SIF for three years.
