



## International Technical Committee for the Apostolate – CTIA

08 – 11 February 2016

The first meeting of the newly constituted CTIA being held at the CTIA hall from 8th February, has come to a close with the morning session of today. As per the established schedule, the meeting covered all the important items on the proposed agenda for the meeting. After being enlightened by the input session of the Superior General, the first item that the meeting took up was to review the existing Statutes of CTIA in view of an eventual updating of the same, if required. The meeting spent quality time in reflecting on the Operative Guidelines of the X General Chapter with special reference to those items pertaining to area of apostolate and especially that which falls within the purview of CTIA. Further, the meeting took a panoramic view of the many apostolic projects and programs in the various stages of their completion. Other themes that the meeting took into consideration were the recommendation of the General Chapter to review and to renew our existing apostolic organizations, the centers of communication studies present in various circumscriptions and their mutual collaboration, and the consolidation of St Paul Biblical centers.

A detailed report on the themes discussed and studied by CTIA along with its recommendations and proposals for necessary approvals and further actions will be submitted to the General Government as soon as possible. The members of CTIA feel confident and happy to put at the service of the same their experience and expertise, their unconditional love and commitment to the mission of the Congregation. The meeting came to a conclusion on a very positive note, the members expressing their gratitude and appreciation to the Superior General and Members of the General Government for entrusting them with such a great responsibility and the communities of the General House and Canonico Chiesa for their warm and fraternal hospitality.
